"Top-flight chardonnay from the cool Wallcliffe sub-region of Margaret River. Made at the hand of Cliff Royle. The flint, the funk, the flesh, the flavour. This serves it all up, and in high style. Grapefruit comes smoothed over with creamy cashew; stonefruit is able with matchstick-y, sulphur-splashed funk. It's in-your-face, in a good way. Long fingers of flavour distinguish the finish."
