| Growing Region: | The fruit for this wine has been sourced from a single vineyard in Wilyabrup from the Margaret River region. This area is renowned for producing Chardonnay's of great varietal characteristics and structure. |
| Grape Variety: | 100% Chardonnay |

| Maturation: | Barrel fermented in a mixture of new and older French oak. Small percentage of malolactic fermentation and lees stirring for added complexity. |
| Colour: | Straw |
| Bouquet: | Vibrant nose of fresh melon, peach and vanilla. |
| Palate: | Soft generous palate of ripe stone fruits and honey with subtle citrus lingering on the finish. |
| Cellaring: | Drink now, medium cellaring potential. |
| Alcohol: | 13.5% |
