“This is something of a ‘do yourself a favour’ wine. It’s the kind of wine that wont leave anyone disappointed, for starters, but its also impressive. Its hearty, stylish, deep-fruited and yet bright. Red liquorice, blackberry, cloves and smoky oak notes, with a gently mineral edge to the tannin finish. Its not loose, its firm. The flesh of the fruit keeps it accessible”.
